

## Future Tense Passive (Shall/Will)

In conjugations 1 & 2, to form the Future use **-bo**, **-bi**, **-bu**;

In conjugations 4 & 3, to form the Future use **-a** and **-e**.

### Passive

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Conjugation

pulsabōr	<i>I shall be hit</i>	pulsabimur	<i>We shall be hit</i>
pulsaberis	<i>You will be hit</i>	pulsabimini	<i>Y'all will be hit</i>
pulsabitur	<i>He will be hit</i>	pulsabuntur	<i>They will be hit</i>

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Conjugation

tenēbōr	<i>I shall be held</i>	tenēbimur	<i>We shall be held</i>
tenēberis	<i>You will be held</i>	tenēbimini	<i>Y'all will be held</i>
tenēbitur	<i>He will be held</i>	tenēbuntur	<i>They will be held</i>

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Conjugation

ponar	<i>I shall be put</i>	ponemur	<i>We shall be placed</i>
poneris	<i>You will be set</i>	ponemini	<i>Y'all will be put</i>
ponentur	<i>He will be placed</i>	ponentur	<i>They will be placed</i>

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Conjugation (-io Verbs)

aspiciar	<i>I shall be looked at</i>	aspiciemur	<i>We will be looked at</i>
aspiceris	<i>You will be looked at</i>	aspiciemini	<i>Y'all will be looked at</i>
aspicietur	<i>He will be looked at</i>	aspicientur	<i>They will be looked at</i>

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Conjugation

audiar	<i>I shall be heard</i>	audiemur	<i>We shall be listened to</i>
audieris	<i>You will be heard</i>	audiemini	<i>Y'all will be heard</i>
audietur	<i>She will be heard</i>	audientur	<i>They will be heard</i>
