

Future Tense Active (*Shall/Will*)

In conjugations 1 & 2, to form the Future use **-bo**, **-bi**, **-bu**;
In conjugations 4 & 3, to form the Future use **-a** and **-e**.

Active

1st Conjugation

pulsa bō	<i>I shall hit</i>	pulsa bi mus	<i>We shall hit</i>
pulsa bis	<i>You will hit</i>	pulsa bitis	<i>You all will hit</i>
pulsa bit	<i>He will hit</i>	pulsa bunt	<i>They will hit</i>

2nd Conjugation

tenē bō	<i>I shall hold</i>	tenē bi mus	<i>We shall hold</i>
tenē bis	<i>You will hold</i>	tenē bitis	<i>Y'all will hold</i>
tenē bit	<i>He will hold</i>	tenē bunt	<i>They will hold</i>

3rd Conjugation

pon a m	<i>I shall put</i>	ponē mus	<i>We shall put</i>
ponē s	<i>You will place</i>	ponē tis	<i>Y'all will place</i>
pon et	<i>He will set</i>	pon ent	<i>They will set</i>

3rd Conjugation (-io Verbs)

aspici a m	<i>I shall look at</i>	aspiciē mus	<i>We shall look at</i>
aspiciē s	<i>You will look at</i>	aspiciē tis	<i>Y'all will look at</i>
aspici et	<i>He will look at</i>	aspici ent	<i>They will look at</i>

4th Conjugation

audi a m	<i>I shall hear</i>	audiē mus	<i>We shall hear</i>
audiē s	<i>You will hear</i>	audiē tis	<i>Y'all will listen to</i>
audi et	<i>He will listen to</i>	audi ent	<i>They will hear</i>

Irregular Verb Sum

erō	<i>I shall be</i>	erimus	<i>We shall be</i>
eris	<i>You will be</i>	eritis	<i>Y'all will be</i>
erit	<i>He will be</i>	erunt	<i>They will be</i>
